0.9% NaCl solution	Also called normal saline, isotonic saline or physiological saline
Adverse event	Includes all immunoglobulin-related side effects and local reactions
BW	Body weight
CHQ-PF50	Child health questionnaire-Parent form 50, a self-administered questionnaire used to assess parent- (or proxy-) reported health status of their children
EHIC	European Health Insurance Card

fSCIG	Facilitated subcutaneous immunoglobulin
