Nursing Guidelines

We Want to Hear from You!

The INGID Board is beginning the process of updating our nursing guidelines. As a first step, we are collaborating with members to develop comprehensive global nursing recommendations for the care and management of people living with immunodeficiencies.

To ensure diverse perspectives, we will use the Nominal Group Technique, a structured approach that prioritizes inclusivity in decision-making. Discussions will be held on Zoom at times that accommodate you and your colleagues. Participation requires a one-time, two-hour commitment, and an honorarium will be provided. Multiple nurses from the same clinic or country are welcome to participate.

This work is being conducted in collaboration with the University of Calgary, and results will be shared on the INGID website for use by members, presented at conferences and submitted for publication. The INGID board will also use the results to inform strategic planning, education events, and advocacy.

As a global organization, it is essential that our recommendations reflect the voices of our members. Your input matters, and we would love to hear from you!
